Financial Obligation Descriptions

Guard Fair Share (\$800)

The Guard Fair Share pays for virtually everything we do. Some of our largest expenses are staff and transportation of our equipment to performance sites. Other expenses include show writing, music purchases, show and sound equipment, competition registrations, equipment purchases, student awards, flags, rifles, and miscellaneous equipment. Following the completion of the marching band season in November, the members of the Guard perform as the Winter Guard. Rehearsals for Winter Guard generally begin in late November, and there are performances throughout the winter and early spring.

Uniform Accessories Packages (\$60/semester)

This includes all of the uniform accessory items for use with the Color Guard & Winter Guard – gloves, shoes, etc. This is a \$120 fee spread over two seasons (\$60 for fall/\$60 for winter). There is also the option of purchasing a Guard warm-up for \$60.

Uniform Purchases (for those Guard members who are also in a concert band)

Effective in the 2014-2015 school year, the concert tuxedos and dresses will be provided by the Band Program to all new students. Older students will wear their pre-owned tuxedos and dresses until they need a fitting change. Students will still be responsible for the purchase of a tuxedo shirt, black bow tie, and cummerbund (men), pearls (women), and black closed toe dress shoes (men and women). The bow tie, cummerbund, and pearls are all purchased through the Band Program.

Concert Instrument Maintenance (\$60/semester)

Each student who uses a school-owned wind instrument for a concert band will pay \$60 per semester for the maintenance of that instrument. Instruments used only occasionally at the discretion of the band directors do not incur a maintenance charge. No student will pay more than \$120 per school year for instrument maintenance. **Unusual or extreme damage resulting in repairs or replacement will be the responsibility of the student.**

Fundraising Credit / Band Accounts

Fundraising credit is used like a “coupon” toward future Winter Park Band expenses. Fundraising credit CANNOT be used for Band meals or fundraising purchases. It is the responsibility of the student and parent to monitor their Charms account and be aware of fundraising credit available to them. Unused fundraising credit rolls over to the next school year. All monies raised through fundraising belong to the Winter Park Band Program and cannot be refunded for any reason. In addition, fundraising credit cannot be transferred from one account to another, with the exception of sibling accounts.
