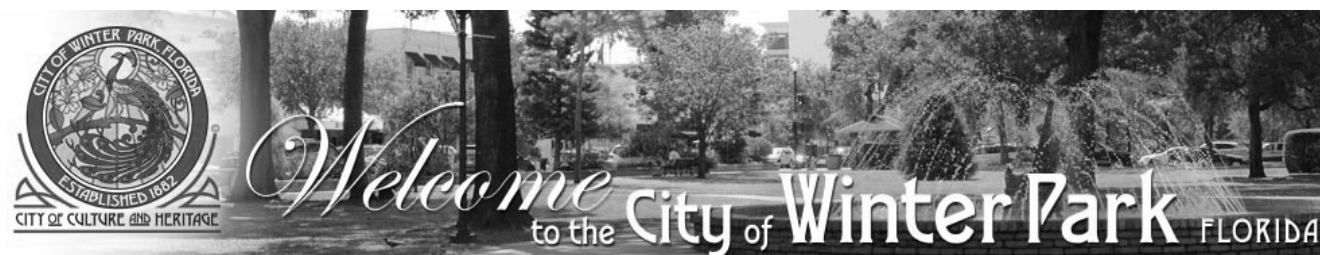

One of the finest cities in the United States, Winter Park is considered by many to be the premier urban village in the Sunshine State. With its rich heritage, strong sense of community, vast parks systems, diverse economic base, and beautiful chain of lakes, the city provides a high quality of life for both residents and visitors alike. Many of the Winter Park community residents are college graduates in professional and business careers producing high academic expectations as well as a history of support for public schools.

Winter Park High School is comprehensive high school located on two campuses: a main campus and a ninth grade center. There are 3,300 students enrolled in ninth through twelfth grades, with over two-hundred staff members. There are a multitude of academic opportunities available to students including the International Baccalaureate program, Advanced Placement and Honors courses, gifted courses, Dual Enrollment courses with Valencia College, the FLIC partnership with Rollins College where students earn college credit, as well as an array of vocational courses.

The Winter Park High School Band Program prides itself on a long-standing tradition of excellence in music education, and is a key component of Winter Park High School's renowned Performing Arts Department. Winter Park Bands have consistently earned "Superior" ratings at Music Performance Assessments. Winter Park High School Band students are regular participants in the Florida All-State Band, the Orange County All-County Band, and Florida Bandmasters district and state solo and ensemble music performance assessments.

The Winter Park Bands have been invited to perform at both regional and national music conventions and festivals, including The Midwest Clinic: An International Band & Orchestra Conference in Chicago, the Bands of America National Festival in Indianapolis, the Florida Music Educators Association State Conference in Tampa, the Southeastern Regional Concert Festival in Atlanta, and the Southern Division College Band Directors National Association/ National Band Association conference in Tampa. The "Sound of the Wildcats" Marching Band has been invited to perform at national events including the Alamo Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Liberty Bowl, and Sugar Bowl. And, in 2016, the Winter Park High School Wind Ensemble made its debut performance in the celebrated Carnegie Hall. In the summer of 2019, the Winter Park High School Wind Symphony also made its debut in the famous Walt Disney Concert Hall, Los Angeles, California.

Michael Clemente, Director of Bands

Michael Clemente is in his eighth year of teaching and his second as the Director of Bands at Winter Park High School. Previously, he served as the Associate Director of Bands at Winter Park High School from 2013 - 2019. Mr. Clemente directs the Wind Symphony, Jazz Ensemble I, and Concert Band, co-directs the "Sound of the Wildcats" Marching Band, and assists with the Symphonic Band, Jazz Ensemble II, and Freshman Jazz Band.

Prior to coming to Winter Park, Mr. Clemente earned his Bachelor of Music Education degree from Michigan State University. A trumpet player, Mr. Clemente has performed with various ensembles both at MSU and in the Lansing (Michigan) area including the MSU Wind Symphony, Symphony Orchestra, Trumpet Ensemble, and the Capitol City Brass Band. He also performed for five years in the Michigan State University Spartan Marching Band, where he served as trumpet section leader and band Vice President. Performances included the Capitol One Bowl, Outback Bowl, BOA Grand National Championships, and the inaugural Big Ten Conference Championship Game where he performed a solo during the halftime show.

From 2008-2010, Mr. Clemente served on the Instructional Staff at Smith Walbridge Clinics in Charleston, IL, one of the oldest and most recognized drum major clinics in the country. While there, he worked with Barry Houser (University of Illinois), Dr. Craig Arhus (Mississippi State University), Dr. Ricky Suk (Ohio University), and Kevin Kastens (University of Iowa). Mr. Clemente is also an alumnus of the Phantom Regiment Drum and Bugle Corps. He toured as a Lead Trumpet player with the Regiment during the summers of 2011 and 2012, performing in multiple stadiums and cities across the country.

Mr. Clemente is an active member of the Florida Bandmasters Association and Florida Music Education Association.



Daniel Smith, Associate Director of Bands



Daniel Smith is in his second year teaching and second year as Associate Director of Bands at Winter Park High School. Mr. Smith directs the Symphonic Band, Jazz Ensemble II, and Freshman Jazz ensemble, co-directs the "Sound of the Wildcats" Marching Band, and assists with the Wind Symphony, Concert Band, and Jazz Ensemble I.

Before his position at Winter Park High School, Mr. Smith earned a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Stetson University in DeLand, FL. While at Stetson Mr. Smith performed with the University Jazz Ensemble, University Symphonic Band, University Symphony Orchestra, University Concert Choir, University Saxophone Ensemble/Quartet, University Clarinet Choir, Southern Winds Symphonic Wind Ensemble, and Stetson Hatter Pep Bands. In the fall of 2017 Mr. Smith had the privilege of performing as a soloist with the University Symphony Orchestra, as one of the winners of the Annual Concerto Competition. Additionally, he was a part of many professional organizations including Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and the Collegiate National Association for Music Education.

Since 2015, Mr. Smith has been very active in the central Florida community working with many different middle and high school band programs as a woodwind technician. Most recently he has helped with organizing and rehearsing the Central Florida Youth Saxophone and Clarinet choirs in Seminole County.

Mr. Smith is an active member of the Florida Bandmasters Association and Florida Music Education Association.

Dear WPHS Band alumni, students, parents, directors, and friends:

Last year we celebrated 80 continuous years of the Winter Park High School Band! Many band alumni attended the Reunion Concert; 18 performed with the Wind Symphony in the final piece, and the WPHSBAA presented a \$6000 check to the band, making the total donated (since 2009) right at \$36,000. To close out the 80th Anniversary Celebration, the Alumni Band played for homecoming in the stands at the game as usual.



Winter Park High School Band Alumni Association is behind the scenes raising funds as you are reading this letter. For this school year, our fundraising purpose has become even more critical. Because of the ability for families zoned for WPHS to choose a virtual education option, funding for some of these students has been redirected away from WPHS, and thus the band program lost some of its regular funding this year. In addition, many families are struggling financially and are having a difficult time paying their band fees. Some of our funds will also be used to help cover the fees for families who are in need due to the loss of a job or other factors courtesy of Covid-19.
